**Open interest Tuesday morning 74 contracts** 

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Live Cattle futures volume was moderately active Monday and ended higher. Outright futures traded between their moving averages. The one significant trading was more narrowing of bear spreads. December is gaining on February and April as it should for the expected strong beef market needed for the holidays.

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Boxed beef was higher Monday but on extremely light sales of total 59 loads. Choice beef load movement was only 25.92 loads and Select beef moved just 11.607 loads. The Choice rib primals were up \$20.59 from Friday. Packers are able to control slaughter in the Midwest and keeping it a level where they can maintain beef prices by limiting cattle killed. It is the Southwest where they need finished cattle they are paying up. The need for high Select beef is also strong helping the Southwestern market. It wouldn't surprise me to see Southwest cattle negotiated prices move above Midwest cattle prices.

Negotiated cattle weights are up. If packers wanted more cattle in Midwest, they could increase kill. On September 29<sup>th</sup>, the last slaughter day of the month, the 5 day accumulated weight for steers was 1,462 pounds versus the current average at 1491 pounds. The average changed from Friday at 1521 pounds to the average Monday at 1491 when cattle from the Southwest were added into the average.

Compared to last week, steers sold 1.00 to 12.00 lower and heifers sold 2.00 to 16.00 lower following a bearish monthly cattle on feed report and a lower CME livestock complex. Moderate to good demand with buyers wanting good long weaned cattle with a couple rounds of shots. Cooler temperatures rolled in this week queuing farmers to wean cattle. Many of the northern states saw a wintery mix making unsafe driving conditions and closing auction barns. Winter weather and a lower board positions helped push the market lower.

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Pork prices were up Monday, but on light sales of 192.96 loads of cuts. Trimmings have become a large part of pork movement. Hog slaughter is up. One day of higher pork prices is not a positive or negative indicator. Pork prices have been dropping and the CME Pork Cutout Index has been narrowing to the CME Lean Hog Index. This is negative for packers.

Pork loins and hams have become a drag on the complex. Loins on the 5 day average are down to \$87.85 and Monday on the daily market were \$86.96. Hams are getting no help for the holiday season and the average price is \$81.16.
