Besides being geographically different, the Southwest and the Midwest are like night and day when it comes to finished cattle and the market reflects it. The heat of the summer was devastating to Southwestern cattle especially to the English breeds. They couldn't maintain any weight and now aren't going to finish out and when available to finish Choice and Select, packers are willing to pay up. Last week, cattle except for a few cattle in the Midwest were priced the same as cattle in the Southwest. There was little change on overall price average.

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Beef prices dropped with biggest drop on Select beef. Choice Beef prices are supported on top cuts, rib and loin primals as buyers fill needs for the holidays. Live Cattle December through April are bear spread as are Live Cattle October 2024 into 2025.

As of October 31, 2023, 2023 dressed steer and heifer carcasses averaged 889.0 pounds up .9 pounds from previous week at 888.1 pounds. The grading percent as of 10/31/23 was 79.0 compared to previous week at 79.4 down .6%. On November 1, 2022 carcasses weighed 890.5 pounds and graded 79.5%.

Hog slaughter continues to increase and packers aren't working hard to find hogs. Last week the CME Pork Index did gain on the CME Lean Hog Index which is positive for packers. The daily pork market changed little compared to a week ago. Pork loins dropped \$1.00 and hams were up \$3.12 but remain cheap at \$83.68. Packers will keep kill up as long as they are making money. Exports remaining strong and need to remain strong into 2024.

Lean Hogs ran up to resistance and highs late September. Funds rolling a big part of trade. Lean Hogs are bear spread December through April.
