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OCTOBER OPEN INTEREST AS OF FRIDAY MORNING WAS 25,702 COMPARED TO PREVIOUS DAY AT 27.762.

THE 5 DAY NEGOTIATED AVERAGE STEER PRICE AS OF OCTOBER 03, 2024 WAS \$186.29. OCTOBER 2024 LIVE CATTLE SETTLED ON OCTOBER 3, 2024 AT \$186.00.

PACKERS ARE BEING PICKY ON HOW THEY ARE BUYING CATTLE. THEY ARE USING SHOWLIST CATTLE AS FILL INS, TAKING A FEW TO FINISH OUT THE DAY AND DEFINITELY NOT TRYING TO PUSH SLAUGHTER.

THURSDAY A FEW MORE CASH CATTLE SOLD BUT SALES STILL ARE LIMITED. PACKERS IN THE MIDWEST PAID \$187.00 FOR FOB CATTLE AND \$295.00 TO \$300.00 ON DRESSED CATTLE. TEXAS SOLD CATTLE AT \$186.00 ON 16 LOADS. KANSAS ON 337 HEAD SOLD CATTLE AT \$185.00

ON WEDNESDAY CATTLE SOLD IN TEXAS FOR \$186.00 FOR FOB 405 STEERS AND HEIFERS AND FOR GRID BASED CATTLE ON 114 HEAD OF STEERS \$188.50. 68 STEERS IN IA/MN SOLD FOR \$187.00. THEY WERE ON THE LIGHT SIDE WEIGHING 1,335.0 POUNDS.

THURSDAY, VOLUME WAS MODERATE. OCTOBER LIVE CATTLE WERE \$1.42 LOWER. FROM DECEMBER ON OUT TRADING WAS JUST THE OPPOSITE OF WEDNESDAY, SPEC TRADERS WERE BEAR SPREADING. THE VOLUME IS SHOWING THE BIG FUNDS ARE STILL ON THE SIDELINES. SPREAD TRADERS ARE MAKING UP MOST OF THE TRADING.

FUNDAMENTAL TRADERS ARE EXPECTING AN OCTOBER RALLY, BUT SLAUGHTER SUGGEST PACKERS ARE GOING TO BUY LIMITED NUMBER OF SHOWLIST CATTLE AND KEEP SLAUGHTER DOWN AND LET FEEDLOTS ADD WEIGHT TO CATTLE.

A YEAR AGO, FROM THE START OF OCTOBER THROUGH DECEMBER, THE DECEMBER 2023/FEBRUARY 2024 LIVE CATTLE SPREAD MOVED FROM OCTOBER 2, 2023 AT MINUS 4.82 TO DECEMBER 29, 2023 AT PLUS 5.17.

SLAUGHTER FOR WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 27TH WAS LIGHT AT 612,00 HEAD, UP 2,000 FROM THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 16,639 FEWER THAN A YEAR AGO FOR THE SAME PERIOD.

EXPORTS

FOR THE WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 26, 2024 EXPORTS WERE 22,500 MT UP 68% FROM THE 4 WEEK AVERAGE. SOUTH KOREA WAS THE LARGEST BUYER TAKING 7900 MT. CHINA WAS THE 2^{ND} LARGEST BUYER TAKING 6200 MT CLOSE TO 3 TIMES WHAT THEY BOUGHT LAST WEEK AT 2100 MT. WITH THE FALL FESTIVAL OVER IN CHINA, THEY LIKELY WERE BUYING TO REPLACE STOCKS USED DURING THE HOLIDAY. .

NATIONAL WEEKLY FED CATTLE COMPREHENSIVE REPORT OCTOBER 01, 2024

AS OF OCTOBER 01, 2024, DRESSED STEER AND HEIFER CARCASSES AVERAGED 913.1 POUNDS, DOWN 2.6 POUNDS FROM PREVIOUS WEEK, AND <u>UP 28.7 POUNDS FROM A YEAR AGO</u>. THE GRADING PERCENT AS OF 10/01/2024 WAS 82.6% COMPARED TO PREVIOUS WEEK AT 82.2% BUT UP <u>4.1% OVER</u> A YEAR AGO AT 78.5%.

Sterling Marketing uses the Comprehensive Beef Cutout Value reported by USDA. I have included a document that explains this cutout value. I looked at this value about 4 years ago and compared the beef packer margin values from my Choice-Select Adjusted value and this Comprehensive value. There was little difference. However, over the past few weeks, the difference has become significant. I believe this is because the mix of cattle slaughtered is increasingly includes higher valued cattle – i.e., Prime, Upper 2/3 Choice, and Branded Program cattle. In addition, it includes the formula-priced cattle. Using just the Choice and higher grade and Select grade to generate the cutout does not reflect this important difference in the quality of cattle which in turn is definitely a driver to the notable improvement in beef demand over the past year.

GOOD DEMAND FOR YEARLING STEERS AND HEIFERS, ESPECIALLY FOR THOSE COMING RIGHT OFF GRASS, AS THE CASH FED CATTLE MARKET HAS MOVED HIGHER AGAIN, AND THE CATTLE FUTURES COMPLEX HAS SEEMED TO FIND SOME SUPPORT. A FEW SPRING BORN CALVES ARE STARTING TO APPEAR IN THE AUCTIONS, MOST CATTLE FEEDERS AREN'T READY TO MESS WITH A BAWLING CALF YET AS THEY ARE BUSY TRYING TO FINISH HARVEST AND THE HOT DAYS AND COOL MORNINGS MAKE IT DIFFICULT TO KEEP A CALF HEALTHY.

PORK PRICES HAVE BEEN SLOWLY WORKING HIGHER. HURRICANE HELENE IN THE SOUTHEAST HAS SLOWED MOVEMENT. SMITHFIELD FOODS SAID TRANSPORTATION FOR HOG PRODUCTION WAS HURT BUT THE PACKING PLANT AND FACILITIES WASN'T DAMAGED. POULTRY PRODUCERS AND PLANT OPERATIONS DID SEE DEATH LOSSES AND PLANT DAMAGES.

LEAN HOG VOLUME WAS MODERATELY ACTIVE ON THURSDAY ABOUT THE SAME AS IT WAS ON WEDNESDAY. SPEC TRADERS CAME INTO THE MARKETS WEDNESDAY AND LEFT ON THURSDAY.

GOING INTO OCTOBER WATCHING THE PRICE OF LOINS AND ESPECIALLY HAM PRICES WILL BE THE MAIN MARKET MOVERS FOR THE PORK COMPLEX. HAM PRICES DROPPED THROUGH SEPTEMBER AS MEXICAN EXPORTS FELL OFF. LOIN PRICES WITH INCREASING HOG INVENETORY COULD COME UNDER PRESSURE.
